The course will take place over four and a half days with an exam in the afternoon of the 5th day. It will comprise of lectures, discussion and practical exercises. The exam will comprise of Multiple Choice Questions. The course content has been assessed as QCF Level 5 (equivalent to Scottish Credit and Qualifications Framework 8, so the level of learning is approximately HND level) and is endorsed by TQUK Ltd. TQUK is regulated by the Office of Qualifications and Examinations Regulation (OFQUAL).
